# Consents Given by Parents

- Outdoor activity consent

- Administration of Calpol and Piriton as required. All medication administration is logged and shared with parents upon return
- Children applying own suncream SPF30+ (own labelled bottle)  
If insect repellent is required/provided, must be roll-on
- Confirmation that tetanus is up to date
- Asthmatics to provide brown inhaler with instructions for usage. Blue inhalers taken from school stock. Administration recorded and shared upon return

# Supervision

- Adult key-carer allocated to each child for the whole week
- Bedrooms located close to an adult room
- Homesickness will be dealt with by offering distraction and reassurance

# Day of Departure

- Own clothes may be worn (comfortable) with a rain coat
- Arrive at school 8:45am, bags on coach, children & parents to Hall for registration and goodbyes
- Depart 9:30am

# Outward Journey

- Travel sickness and medication administered at home before departure, logged at registration time
- Comfort breaks as and when required
- Stop-off at Moors Valley
- Text message to parents c. 5pm to confirm arrival at hotel

# Return Journey
