Home School Book

- Please read with your child for at least ten minutes daily
- Record reading in the Home School Book
- Please check in this book daily as teachers can use this as a means of communication with a focus on Reading
- You may record notes and queries for teachers in this book

Homework

- English: Handed out **Monday** to be returned **Wednesday**
- Maths: Handed out <u>Friday</u> to be returned <u>Monday</u>
- Spellings: Handed out <u>Wednesday</u> with test the following <u>Wednesday</u>
- All homework will be recorded each week by your child in their Home School Book
- KS2 Homework club is available on a Monday lunchtime

Reading

- Children are expected to read regularly at home with an adult –
 10-15 minutes a day; to be recorded in Home School Book
- Regular library slots in school for home and class reading
- Class reading: children will have an appropriate guided reading book to read and discuss in class each week
- Teachers read to the class every day promoting a positive attitude to books and an enjoyment of reading.

Curriculum

English

- The Power of Reading: Our English will be based on The Power of Reading and centred around a book. This term we will be focussing on How To Train Your Dragon by Cressida Cowell and Aladdin by Phillip Pullman.
- We will cover a range of genres and produce non-fiction, narrative and poetry work.
- As part of the curriculum there will be a grammar and comprehension lesson taught weekly.

Curriculum (cont.)

- Maths: We cover all areas of the National Curriculum and work will be appropriately differentiated. Problem solving will be an essential part of the curriculum.
- Maths passports: These will be used weekly to develop the children's mental maths skills.
- **Times tables**: By the end of Year 4 all children are expected to know all of their times tables by heart. We will practice these weekly through the times tables challenge. Please support your child in learning these at home.

- Science: Changing state and animals including Humans
- History and Geography: Anglo Saxons and time zones
- Art and Design Technology: Henry Moore sculptures and purse making
- PE: Healthy body fitness circuits and balance and coordination
