



Summer Term Health and Welfare

Sun Screen

On sunny days please apply sun screen to your child BEFORE their arrival at school. We are not able to apply sun cream to children during the school day and discourage bottles of cream being brought to school; multiple bottles cause storage issues, they can spill in book bags, children applying their own sun cream disturb other children and leaves the child with very greasy hands and fingers.

Hats

Please ensure your child is sent to school with an appropriate sun hat. These are essential for our out-door classroom work and for break times.



Water

Throughout the school day children have access to fresh drinking water via the water fountains in the playgrounds. Nursery children are offered water at intervals throughout the day. Children may bring a water bottle to school and can have access to this during lessons, provided the bottle has a spill-proof top and that the bottle has not been frozen in an attempt to keep the drink cool. Please ensure all bottles are clearly labelled with your child's name.

Hayfever

If your child suffers from hayfever please administer appropriate medication at home prior to bringing your child to school. Many shop bought medications are effective for a whole day and mean that additional medication is not required throughout the school day. If your child does require medication (for hayfever or otherwise) to be administered at school this MUST be prescribed by a doctor and be labelled clearly.
